The **21st Century Community Learning Grant** will provide opportunities for academic enrichment, including tutorial services to help students, particularly students who attend low-performing schools, to meet State and local student academic achievement standards in core academic subjects, such as reading and mathematics.

Selected students will be offered a broad array of additional services, programs, and activities, such as youth development activities, drug and violence prevention programs, counseling programs, art, music, and recreation programs, technology education programs, and character education programs, that are designed to reinforce and complement the regular academic program of participating students.

The grant will also be designed to offer families of students served by community learning centers opportunities for literacy and related educational development.
